Special Program on COVID-19

Compact Foundation has taken Special Program on **COVID-19**. Through this Program, Compact Foundation has distributed huge number of **Face mask** among the local people to protect Corona virus attack. The organization also distributed Relief goods especially Food items like Rice, Dal, Potato, Soybean oil, Sault etc among the jobless and poor people.

















Gender Development

Regular motivation/awareness raising discussions are held among the beneficiaries in weekly group meetings. Special seminar workshops on legal aid are being organized with the government officials, public representatives and by the participation of men/women.



Health, Nutrition and MCH:

Government health services at the rural situation are sub-standard at all level and beyond the reach of the poor communities. To aware the group people on the primary health issues different types of interventions are implemented under this head. The activities are motivation, awareness raising, PHC education, cadres training to pregnant mother, TBA training, EPI, balanced diet preparation, ORS preparation and use, nutritional awareness and family planning.

















It is also working on growth monitoring of the severely malnourished children and pregnant mothers, lactating mothers etc. Regular check up of the adolescent girls and pregnant mothers and injecting TT for their safety. It advocates for contraceptives use, ligation, Vasectomy, Copper-T etc. and interested couples are sent to Government Hospitals. CF has been implementing this program with assistances of **Ministry of Health & Family Welfare**.

Prevention of Trafficking.

CF has been working on prevention of trafficking of children and women with the supports of **Department of Social Service.** The project is Combat in Persons through Community Mobilization and the main activities are awareness, school campaigns, bazzar meetings, group meetings, Uthan boitak etc. It develops Community Trafficking Forum (CTF) from community and mobilizes them for working for prevention of trafficking in the project areas.





Adolescent development program:

CF has been working for the poor adolescent girls of the working areas for their life development since its inception. Already a good number of adolescent girls have become aware and skilled about their lives. The program has become accepted highly and need is increasing. Due to limitation it cannot increase the program. So, we need supports from all concerns.







Disables development Program:

CF especially emphasis the development of the disabled people and especially considers the children. CF has been included a total 260 disabled children with its disability development program. It has 1 CHDRP, and one Social Communicator.







The main activities are: motivation, awareness raising, Uthan boitak, IEC/BCC materials support, advocacy, group meetings, leaflet distributions, workshops, seminars, etc. It also provides disability aid materials like crutches, spectacles, wheel chairs etc. to the poor disabled children. CF has been implementing this program with assistance of **Bangladesh Protibondi Unnayan Foundation.**

Early Marriage Prevention Program:

Early Marriage Remove program is the burning issue in Bangladesh. Compact Foundation(CF) has been implementing this program through motivational work through Group meetings, advocacy activities etc in Chuadanga district.



Women Empowerment Program:

Half of the total population in Bangladesh is female. But women are not socially well permitted to go out of the family, participate in education and economic activities. They are the victims of social diseases like divorce, abandoned, husband separation, polygamy, dowry early marriage and torturing. Moreover being a traditional segregated society, women are often denied to access to many opportunities. They have no Income sources. As a result, women are not empowered in the family. Compact Foundation has been trying to empower the women through leadership development and Skill based training.









WASH Program:

In rural areas of Bangladesh, generally the people do not sue pure drinking water and water sealed Latrines. As a result different water borne diseases spread out and attacks the people and kills lot of valuable lives in each year at undue period. Considering the importance, Compact Foundation (CF) has been implementing pure drinking water supply and Sanitation programs in its working areas.





Climate Change Program:

Climate Change is one of the most important issues of the world. Now the world is threaded by various pollution like Air, Water, and Land etc which affected already on our human beings. To prevent environmental degradation, Compact Foundation (CF) is implementing motivational work, Training, home based Tree plantation program.



Agriculture Development Project:

Compact Foundation(CF) has been transferring the Agricultural technology at farmers level for utilizing organic manure of common peoples vegetable production etc. CF supporting its beneficiaries in this sector through Training support.

Bee Cultivation:

The Bee culture can contribute in socio-economic development of the poor. It can create jobs for jobless people and can ensure food security. It is environment friendly activities. We can get our important medicinal food like honey which we can ensure from bee cultivation. The organization has been implementing this program with assistance Ministry of Science & Technology.



Anti Tobacco and Drug Control Program:

Anti Tobacco is one of the most important issues in this time. It is very essential for health & Environment. Compact Foundation is implementing this program through arrangement of Seminar, Motivation & Poster distribution. Anti Drug are very sensitive issues of Bangladesh. The Young generation are going to be addicted through drug use. Compact Foundation Trying to control drug use through motivational works.





Migration Program:

Migration Problem is one of the main problems in Bangladesh. It is threaten for humanity. For better life and job opportunities, men and women change their living places. But a big number of migrated people become false prostitution for their ignorance. Social criminals and corrupted peoples are involved in this activities. Many people losing their wealth and lives causes of social criminals and corrupted peoples. For safe migration, Compact Foundation(CF) working in Chuadanga district through motivational and training activities. .

Execution & Management of the organization:

Compact Foundation(CF) adopt decentralized participatory management system in program implementation. The General body, the supreme authority of the organization consists of 21 members. A 7 member Executive committee is elected biennially out of General body for policy making and program execution. All the policies of executive committee are implemented by the modest staff headed by the Executive Director, who is responsible for overall program implementation and management.

At top, mid and field level, the activities of CF are managed by development workers with long year's professional experiences. Its programs are implemented through participation of all levels of workers within the frame work of Action-plan. Each level of management is encouraged to accept council and advice of the authority concerned to embrace creative solution. They are also encouraged for team spirit and to motivate them to know much. CF provides its workers liberty to take initiative, stimulating participation and continuous search for up-gradation in terms of quality and quantity.

Financial Strategy of the organization:

Compact Foundation (CF) is financially capable to implement any kind of development program. The Fund, receiving from different sources for the purpose of the organization, is accumulated into a Bank account. If the money is needed to withdraw from Bank, the transaction is dealt with joint signatures of the President, Secretary and treasurer. 
Monitoring:
